

## CATEGORIES OF THE WILL OF GOD FOR DIVINE GUIDANCE

1. The operational will of God. What does God want me to do?
  - A. This is the same for every believer.
  - B. The believer is to be filled with the Spirit, and to grow in GRACE.
  - C. This is correspondence with the principle of yieldedness, filling of the Spirit.
  - D. Specifics, the Divine operating assets; Utilized in the will of God, are given by GRACE.
    1. The canon of Scripture.
    2. The local church.
    3. Pastor-Teacher, evangelist, other spiritual gifts.
    4. Indwelling of God the Holy Spirit.
    5. Restoration back into fellowship by GRACE.
    6. Breathing apparatus for the soul to function.
    7. The mind.
    8. The human spirit.
    9. The believer's priesthood.

Also: Faith in the promises of God, living in the Word, occupation with the Person of Jesus Christ, prayer, witnessing, etc.

2. The viewpoint will of God: what does God want me to think?
  - A. This is the same for all believers.
  - B. His viewpoint, will, is what He wants us to think, the Divine Viewpoint.
  - C. Divine Viewpoint comes from knowledge of the Word of God.
  - D. This corresponds with the first principle, knowledge of the Word, leads to the will of God.
  - E. With the Word of God in your human spirit, comes growth and maturity.
3. The geographical will of God: where does God want me to go?
  - A. This is different for all believers. (Except if you are married).
  - B. Is there a specific area of service for this specific time?
  - C. The issue: If you are in fellowship, filled with the Spirit, and respect the authority of the communicated Word, and comprehend the Word and believe it and accept it by faith, this will give you a frame of reference and a Divine norm and standard, and you will have no problem with geography.
